

Directions for Infants' Acetaminophen Oral Suspension 160 mg/5 mL

(Brands like **TYLENOL**®, **Pediacare**®, **Triaminic**®, **America's Choice**®, **Equaline**®, **CVS**®, or **Walgreens**®)

Healthcare Provider: Use this form to indicate the proper dosing of infants' acetaminophen oral suspension for the child named below.

CHILD'S WEIGHT AND AGE (Healthcare Provider checks one)

- 6-11 lbs** (0-3 months)
- 12-17 lbs** (4-11 months)
- 18-23 lbs** (12-23 months)
- 24-35 lbs** (2-3 years)

Always remember, for children under 2 years of age, only a healthcare provider can give you the right dose for your child.

DOSE (Healthcare Provider fills in)

Acetaminophen 160 mg/5mL		
6-11 lbs	0-3 months	1.25 mL
12-17 lbs	4-11 months	2.5 mL
18-23 lbs	12-23 months	3.75 mL
24-35 lbs	24-36 months	5.0 mL

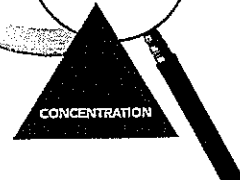
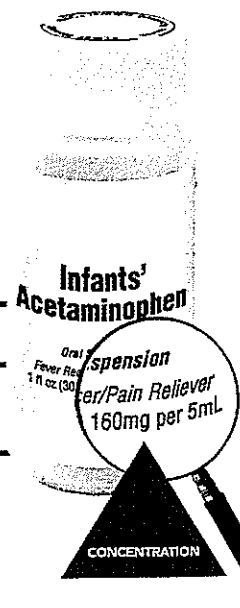
Give your child the dose indicated every 4 hours as needed. Do not give more than 5 doses in 24 hours.

This dose is for use only in the treatment of your child's current fever or pain. The next time your child needs a pain or fever reliever, you will have to call your child's healthcare professional to request the appropriate dose.

- This dosage is for infants' acetaminophen oral suspension with a concentration of 160 mg/5 mL. Before purchasing or dosing the medicine, confirm the concentration.
- To find the concentration, look on the front of the bottle label or in the Drug Facts section.
- If you see a concentration of 80 mg/0.8 mL, or the words "concentrated drops" on the bottle, **call your Healthcare Provider for the correct dose.**
